

Adjective Order in English

Placing adjectives correctly in English can be tricky, especially for non-native speakers. Use this friendly acronym to help your order them: **OSASCOMP**.

- O
Opinion: *expensive, perfect, beautiful, cheap, wonderful, etc.*
(Opinión: caro, perfecto, hermoso, barato, maravilloso, etc.)
- S
Size: *large, small, tiny, etc.*
(Tamaño: grande, pequeño, diminuto, etc.)
- A
Age: *old, new, modern, young, etc.*
(Edad: viejo, nuevo, moderno, joven, etc.)
- S
Shape: *round, square, long, thin, etc.*
(Forma: redondo, cuadrado, largo, delgado, etc.)
- C
Color: *white, pink, red, green, etc.*
(Color: blanco, rosa, rojo, verde, etc.)
- O
Origin: *Colombian, Greek, Turkish, etc.*
(Origen: colombiano, griego, turco, etc.)
- M
Material: *silk, polyester, marble, leather.*
(Material: seda, poliéster, mármol, cuero.)
- P
Purpose: *wedding, sleeping, etc.*
(Propósito: de matrimonio, de dormir, etc.)

Examples:

The expensive large old round pink French porcelain dinner plate is my mother's.

(El costoso plato grande, viejo, redondo, de porcelana francesa rosa, es de mi madre)

I bought a beautiful Colombian emerald necklace.

(Compré un hermoso collar de esmeraldas colombianas)
