

# The most common verbs in English and how to use them



## 1. To be – (ser o estar)

- I am
- We, they, you are
- He, she, it is

I am who I am.  
Yo soy quien soy.  
You are at home.  
Tú estás en casa.

(Como puedes observar, en español usamos dos verbos diferentes, ser y estar, mientras que en inglés solo existe un verbo -to be- para ambos significados).

## 2. To have – (tener)

- I have
- We, they, you have
- he, she, it has

She has everything her heart desires.  
Ella tiene todo lo que su corazón desea.

## 3. To do – (hacer)

- I do
- We, they, you do
- he, she, it does

I do my homework.  
Yo hago mi tarea.  
She does exercise.  
Ella hace ejercicio.

## 4. To say – (decir)

- I say
  - We, they, you say
  - he, she, it says
- You say the most fascinating things in the world.  
Tú dices las cosas increíbles del planeta.

## 5. To get – (obtener)

- I get
  - We, they, you get
  - he, she, it gets
- I get good marks because I study a lot.  
Yo obtengo buenas notas porque estudio mucho.

## 6. To make – (hacer)

- I make
  - We, they, you make
  - he, she, it makes
- It makes me feel scared.  
Eso me hace sentir asustado.

## 7. To go – (ir)

- I go
  - We, they, you go
  - he, she, it goes
- I go to my psychiatrist three times a week.  
Voy al psiquiatra tres veces a la semana.

## 8. To know – (saber, conocer)

- I know
  - We, they, you know
  - he, she, it knows
- I know everything about the history of France.  
Lo sé todo sobre la historia de Francia.

## 9. To take – (tomar)

- I take
  - We, they, you take
  - he, she, it takes
- This is the deal. Take it or leave it.  
Este es el trato. Lo tomas o lo dejas.

## 10. To see – (ver)

- I see
  - We, they, you see
  - he, she, it sees
- I can see what this is all about.  
Puedo ver de qué se trata todo esto.

## 11. To come – (venir)

- I come
- We, they, you come
- he, she, it comes

The double steak burger? It comes with mayo, coke and fries on the menu!  
¿La hamburguesa doble? ¡Viene con mayonesa, Coca-Cola y papas fritas!

## 12. To think – (pensar)

- I think
- We, they, you think
- he, she, it thinks

I think she is happy.  
Yo pienso que ella es feliz.

## 13. To look – (mirar)

- I look
- We, they, you look
- he, she, it looks

Look outside! It is raining again.  
¡Mira fuera! Está lloviendo otra vez.

## 14. To want – (querer)

- I want
  - We, they, you want
  - he, she, it wants
- I want it all, and I want it now!  
¡Lo quiero todo, y lo quiero ahora!

## 15. To give – (dar)

- I give
  - We, they, you give
  - he, she, it gives
- I am going to give you some tips.  
Te voy a dar algunos consejos.

## 16. To use – (usar)

- I use
  - We, they, you use
  - he, she, it uses
- At this restaurant, they use the finest ingredients.  
En este restaurante usan los mejores ingredientes.

## 17. To find – (encontrar)

- I find
  - We, they, you find
  - he, she, it finds
- She always finds a good excuse.  
Ella siempre encuentra una buena excusa.

## 18. To tell – (decirle algo a alguien)

- I tell
  - We, they, you tell
  - he, she, it tells
- He tells me he is tired of you.  
Él me dice que está aburrido de ti.

## 19. To ask – (preguntar)

- I ask
  - We, they, you ask
  - he, she, it asks
- He asks me the same all the time.  
Él me pregunta lo mismo todo el tiempo.

## 20. To work – (trabajar)

- I work
  - We, they, you work
  - he, she, it works
- I work 24/7.  
Yo trabajo las 24 horas del día, los siete días de la semana.
